Located east of Pima Road, between Great Wolf Lodge Arizona and Salt River Fields, the Memorial Gardens includes a piece of the original boathouse from the USS Arizona. This piece was part of the original memorial at Pearl Harbor for ten years. When completed, the Gardens will give visitors an opportunity to learn more about December 7, 1941, and a chance to reflect on that historic day and the impact it had on so many.
